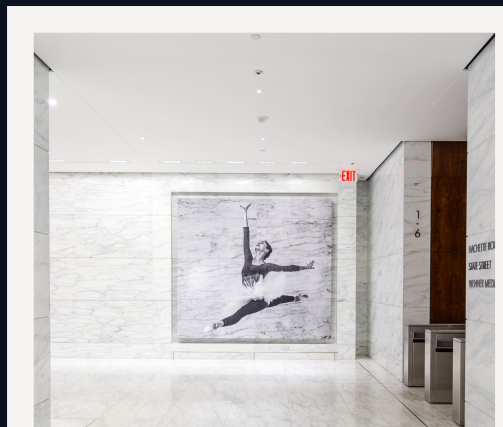

Extended over the entire block between 51st and 52nd St on the Eastern side of 6th Ave, this 45 stories tower (43 office floors and 2 concourse levels) was originally built in 1963 and contains over 190,000 m<sup>2</sup> of leasable space.

In 2012 Vornado, owner of this building, announced the beginning of the renovation process, with the MGI Group supplying the Statuario Caldia® marble in cut to size panels for the walls and floors of the entire lobby area, including the North and South corridors leading to the elevator cabs; a total of 3,000 m<sup>2</sup> of honed marble panels were installed.
