Originally built in 1965 and designed by Emory Roth & Sons Architects, 1330 Avenue of the Americas is a 40 stories premier skyscraper which offers a variety of five-star amenities and services to its tenants. In 2012 the building was bought by RXR Realty LLC who started a \$30 million dollar renovation process of the facade, lobby, corridors and elevators. 1330 AoA features contemporary on-trend designs completed with high ceilings, abundant light, and efficient layouts. The Statuario Caldia® marble was chosen by MdeAS Architects as one of the new materials to be installed for the new floors and approximately 5,000 m² of 60 x 60 cm were supplied in 2 cm thickness.
