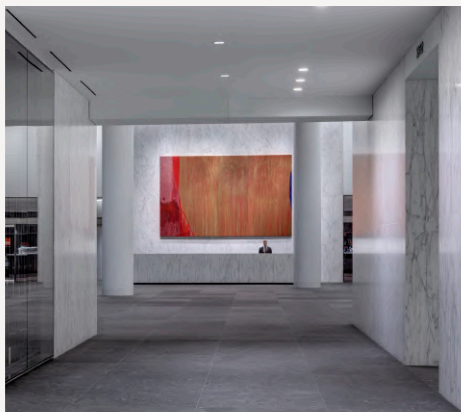

Located in Denver's central business district, 1801 California Street, formerly known as Qwest Tower, is a 54-story office building containing 130,000 m² of rentable space; it is the second tallest building in Denver. Brookfield bought the property in December of 2011 and started a renovation process aimed to attract new tenants thanks to a revamped lobby, a fitness centre and a new restaurant.

The project consisted of approximately 1,500 m² of 3 cm honed Statuario Caldia® marble panels and 700 m² of Statuario Caldia® mosaics.
