Built on the ashes of the old Milliken Building, 7 Bryant Park is a 30-story, 44,000 m² office tower on the corner of 40th St and 6th Ave, designed by world class architect Henry N. Cobb. The Calacatta Caldia® marble supplied by the MGI Group is the choice for the new lobby, with approximately 270 m² of cut to size panels fabricated for paving and walls from 3 cm slabs; the remaining 10 m², in 2 cm panels, were used inside the elevator cabs. The unique pattern mixing different materials in different shapes granted this carefully detailed lobby the 2019 Grande Pinnacle Award.
