Baglio Assuli is a modern winery that matches tradition and innovation in a magical location where the horizon blends with the gentle profile of the countryside. An immense multifunctional structure that embraces the hills surrounding it, underlining the strong connection with the territory. A combination reaffirmed by the use of local materials such as Marsala tuff, Custonaci marble, Sicilian typical tiles, which create a structure in perfect harmony with nature, where simple and complex geometries merge in an unparalleled elegance. The marble floors - supplied by the MGI Group in different finishings - are more than 3,500 m², of which 700 m² of the cellar's claddings are made of Perlato Sicilia Cofano® and Riviera Beige® marbles.
