In a charmed Upper East Side location, this large, 31 stories red-brick apartment tower, located at 200 East 94th Street, was designed by Davis Brody Bond and completed in 1986. Related announced its condo conversion in 2014, with amenities redesigned by Robert A.M. Stern Architects and a total units count brought to 325 condos from the original 368 rentals. Carnegie Park features timeless elegance with vibrant amenity spaces.

The MGI Group fabricated and supplied its Statuario Caldia® and Bardiglio marbles for the complete restyling of the master and secondary bathrooms, including vanity tops, floor tiles and wall mosaic. At the end of the project, which was divided into 3 separate phases, more than 4,500 m² of tiles and mosaic and 290 vanity tops were supplied.
