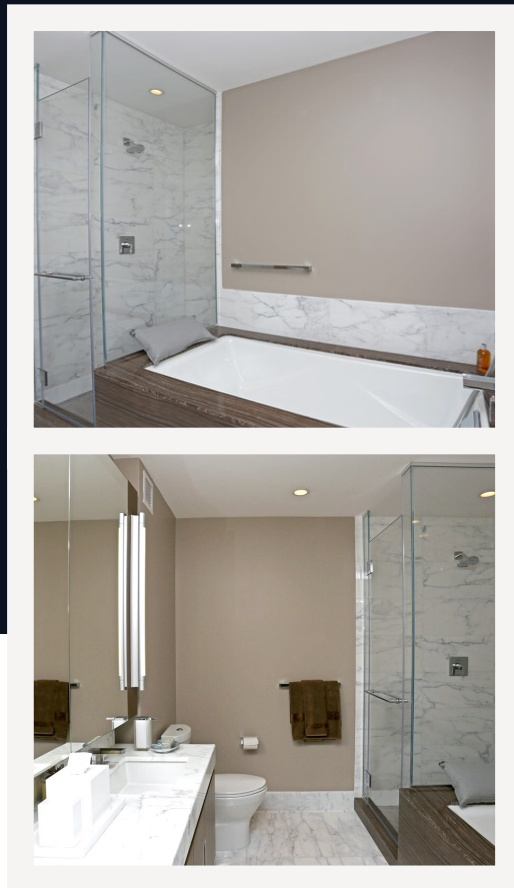

One MiMa Tower is a 63-story glass building designed by Bernardo Fort-Brescia, principal of the firm Arquitectonica, featuring luxury rentals and condominium residences in Midtown Manhattan (hence the name); the apartments, which occupy the 12 top floors of the tower, are among the most luxurious in New York City, offering an unprecedented level of exclusivity and services to their tenants. The MGI Group supplied its honed Calacatta Caldia® marble for the covering of the bathrooms' floors and Nero Marquina for the walls, plus elegant kitchen countertops cut from Bianco Carrara 2 cm slabs.
