The Selfridges & Co. is one of the highend department stores in the United Kingdom. The flagship store in London's Oxford Street is the second largest shop in the UK (after Harrods) and opened on March 15, 1909. Selfridges enlisted architect Alex Cochrane to redesign their menswear department store and the honed Statuario Caldia® marble was the material chosen to be installed on the new floor. A total of 264 hexagonal pieces (with 365 mm radius) were cut starting from 2 cm slabs to cover an area of approximately 280 m².
