Part of the \$250-million renovation of the retail and public space known as Brookfield Place, designed by architect César Pelli, Hudson Eats is a 3,500 m² upscale dining terrace (opened in 2014) that offers a selection of 14 dining experiences and up to 600 seats.

The MGI Group supplied approximately 550 m² of its Calacatta Caldia® mosaics, in different sizes and shapes, for the covering of the round and square columns, more than 20 dining tables (cut from 3, 4 and 6 cm slabs) and vanity tops for 2 restrooms.
