Completed in 2013, this 180-meter long marble corridor (officially known as WTC West Concourse) links the World Trade Center PATH Station with Brookfield Place on its east side and the Battery Park City Ferry Terminal on its west side. It was the first part of the \$3.9 billion new transit hub, designed by architect Santiago Calatrava, to open to the public. 900 m² of Statuario Caldia® wall panels were installed in the area where six escalators lead to the entrance of the Brookfield Place pavilion.
