A precious stone geometry designs the lobby at New York-Presbyterian Brooklyn Methodist Hospital, a contemporary and functional healthcare center. The Calacatta Caldia® marble supplied by the MGI Group covers an outstanding Art Wall designed by Perkins Eastman. The architects have designed a corner wall consisting of two panels each measuring 8 x 6 meters in 5-layers Calacatta Caldia® marble with unvarying color and directional veining, carefully selected from a single block of extra quality, mapping each slab with advanced photographic scanners. The double wall turns a common partition into a vibrant structure where several marble modules create a unique effect, each unit acting by transforming the whole system into a dynamic wall: a really impressive masterpiece, awarded the prestigious Pinnacle Award 2021.
